What is China's new solar PV capacity?

China's National Energy Administration has unveiled that the country's newly added solar PV capacity in the first quarter of 2024 was 45.74GW, up from 33.66GW in the same quarter last year. Previous data from the energy administration showed that the newly installed PV capacity in the first two months was 36.72GW.

When will China's solar power capacity reach 1000 GW?

Rystad Energy modeling shows total installed solar photovoltaic (PV) capacity in China will cross the 1,000 GW mark by the end of 2026. New capacity in 2023 is expected to top 150 GW, almost doubling the 87 GW installed in 2022. Our projections show that the significant acceleration is not going to slow anytime soon.

How many solar panels are installed in China?

China's new installed PV capacity was 87.41GW, an increase of 59.3% year-on-year; of which, the distributed installed about 51.1GW, accounting for 60% of all new installations. Residential PV installation reached 25.3GW, up 16.9% year-on-year, accounting for 28.9% of all new installations.

What happened to China's photovoltaic installed capacity in 2019?

In 2019, even though China's photovoltaic installed capacity dropped again, the newly added and accumulated photovoltaic installed capacity continued to rank first in the world.

How many solar panels are there in China in 2023?

Last year, centralised PV installation capacity reached approximately 119GW, higher than distributed solar PV installation's record of about 96GW. New PV capacity in China reached 216.88GW in 2023, a 148.12% year-on-year increase, according to the National Energy Administration of China.
