



How to remove the battery of the smart storage travel box

How do I remove a battery from a smart bag?

Some are more complicated than others, but the general instructions for removing those batteries are: Empty the smart bag so you can access the interior liner of the bag. Unzip the interior liner to find the battery pack. It's usually located at the top or bottom of the bag.

Are batteries allowed in smart luggage?

Only those with non-removable batteries are banned if you're traveling with smart luggage. Smart baggage with detachable batteries is still permitted, but you may only bring the battery onboard; it cannot be checked. This restriction does not apply to conventional AA batteries; rather, it applies only to lithium-ion and lithium-metal batteries.

How does a smart luggage tracker work?
