Why does my battery make a noise when charging?

There are going to be some sort of sine with distortion and noise coming from your wall and while it's charging the chargers doing what it's supposed to do, but when your battery is fully charged, the filtering noise occasionally get loud on certain chargers.

Why does my laptop make a noise when charging?

There's a comment that a "charger that generates coil noise especially when under load may be defective" (which I believe means, if the noise occurs when the laptop is connected, but not when the charger is connected to the mains without being connected to the laptop).

Why does my electrical system make a buzzing sound?

Many electrical systems and products produce a buzzing sound as the electric current flows through the wiring. Buzzing sounds are especially common in grounded outlets, which protect the outlet and device from an electrical surge. But if you hear a louder buzzing sound right as you go to plug something in, that could be an issue.

Is it normal to hear a buzzing noise when charging?

It is normal to hear a little buzzing noise when you are charging your device, however, if you feel that the buzzing noise is far from normal it is possible that the charging port or adapter is damaged. Check the AC adapter and cables (including the power cable) for any signs of physical damage. Also, try to connect to a different wall outlet.

Does leaving a battery plugged in degrade the battery over time?

Yes, leaving a device plugged in will degrade the battery over time. Especially lithium. Lithium likes to hover around 60 to 80 percent charge. When it sits at 100 it will drain a little faster and the charge circuit wants to keep it at 100. This effectively eats the charge cycles of the battery.

What does a laptop sound like?

The sound is a low "buzz" or "fizz", sawtooth sound, a little like crickets (cicadas), or like a lower-pitched constant version of the sound of a fizzy coke bottle being opened. It is much louder when the laptop is connected.
